1. Authentic Faith	Know who God is, including names and attributes	Love God (Great Commandment)	Ability to connect saving faith to everyday life
2. Solid Biblical Understanding	Biblical literacy including the overall redemption story of Scripture, Christ in the Old and New Testament, overview of each book	Love God's Word, believing it to be completely relevant, sufficient and authoritative, and using it as the guiding authority in their lives	Ability to discern truth and error, habitually read the Bible, inductive Bible study skills
3. Gospel-Centered Lives	Solid understanding of the relevance and impact of the gospel	Belief in core elements of the gospel	Share the gospel
4. Habitual Spiritual Disciplines	Bible Study, Scripture memorization	Prayer, Worship, Fasting	Charity, Giving
5. Biblical Worldview	Know what the Bible says about morality and ethics	Biblical morals guiding life and transforming character	Moral conviction driving compassionate action
6. Love for Others	Understand God's call to love others (Great Commandment)	Desire to love others	Practically serve others using spiritual gifts, engage in missions (Great Commission)
